## **BACK TO SCHOOL HEALTH FAIR**

In August 2022, with the support of private donors and the Rotary Club of Sonoma Springs, SVCHC provided backpacks during the 2022 back to school event at Altimira Middle School. This event also included a Covid-19 vaccine clinic.

- Over 600 backpacks were distributed to K-12 students
- Over 1000 attendees
- More than 30 booths from local and county wide community organizations were present

## **COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT**

#### Food Distributions (ongoing)

- Distributed over 1100 food bags at REFB on-site distribution
- Included other, non-food items such as diapers and pull-ups
- Bi-monthly effort from staff and 700 hours of local volunteers
- Farm to Pantry provided 280 bi-monthly food boxes to SVCHC patients

#### Volunteer support totaling over 2600 hours

- SVCHC On-site clinic- almost 1200 hours
- Pop-up Clinics 70 hours
- Pediatric clinics 400 hours
- Back to School Health Fair 180 hours
- Other special events 60 hours
