COVID-19 VACCINE CLINICS

January to December

SVCHC On-Site Vaccine Clinics (ongoing)

- Over 4600 people vaccinated
- Includes over 3500 booster shots
- Supported by volunteers, Lideres Campesinas and La Luz Center's Luchadoras
- Funded in part by HRSA - Health Resources and Services Administration

SVCHC Off-site Vaccination Clinics

- In partnership with the County of Sonoma, Sonoma Valley School Unified District, Sonoma Valley Hospital, Hanna Boys Center, Boys & Girls Club of Sonoma Valley, MCUI, Cogir Sonoma, and Sonoma Hills

Multiple Locations:

- Almost 1000 people vaccinated
- Cogir Sonoma (3 different times)
- Sonoma Hills retirement home (2 different times)
- Movimiento Cultural de la Unión Indígena (MCUI) Fruits of Labor Screening event
- Hanna Boys Center

Pediatric Pop-Up Vaccination Clinics

- In partnership with the County of Sonoma, Sonoma Valley School District, Sonoma Valley Hospital, and Boys and Girls Club of Sonoma Valley
- Almost 1000 children and adolescents vaccinated
- Supported by volunteers, Lideres Campesinas and La Luz Center's Luchadoras

SVCHC Off-Site Flu Clinics

- Over 200 people vaccinated
- Supported by volunteers and Sonoma Valley Hospital

SVCHC On-Site Flu Shots(ongoing)

- Over 1686 people vaccinated
- Supported by SVCHC staff

Other Immunizations

SVCHC participates in the Vaccine for Children and the Vaccine for Adults programs. These programs allow SVCHC to administer low cost vaccines to the uninsured and underinsured.

COMMUNITY RELATED EVENTS

BACK TO SCHOOL HEALTH FAIR

In August 2022, with the support of private donors and the Rotary Club of Sonoma Springs, SVCHC provided backpacks during the 2022 back to school event at Altimira Middle School. This event also included a Covid-19 vaccine clinic.

- Over 600 backpacks were distributed to K-12 students
- Over 1000 attendees
- More than 30 booths from local and county wide community organizations were present

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

Food Distributions (ongoing)

- Distributed over 1100 food bags at REFB on-site distribution
- Included other, non-food items such as diapers and pull-ups
- Bi-monthly effort from staff and 700 hours of local volunteers
- Farm to Pantry provided 280 bi-monthly food boxes to SVCHC patients

Volunteer support totaling over 2600 hours

- SVCHC On-site clinic- almost 1200 hours
- Pop-up Clinics - 70 hours
- Pediatric clinics - 400 hours
- Back to School Health Fair - 180 hours
- Other special events - 60 hours

And over 2100 home COVID kits provided to the community!
